



Summer/Fall Internship Program

Start date: May 15th or earlier (Summer) ~ Sept 1st (Fall) or earlier

Ending date: August 15th or later (Summer) ~ December 1st or later (Fall)

Hourly wage: \$10 **Hours per week:** 60+ (minimum)

**We pay every Monday

**We offer direct deposit

Living arrangements: Housing is provided as part of the internship in the main level apartment of the farm house on the farm. The bedroom is furnished with bed and night stand, and a full bathroom is shared. There is internet available at the house and free Wi Fi at the farm building. Please feel free to bring your own bedding, towels and kitchen utensils. The washer/dryer and kitchen is shared with fellow FT employees.

Time off: 6 days off a month. Usually one day a week and one weekend a month (F/S or a S/S). Plan to work most Sundays.

Job Duties include:

- Working with Show Cows & Heifers - includes washing, feeding, leading
- Working with potential sale cattle – includes washing, feeding, leading
- Being a part of our “Barn Crew” that assists with daily milking, feeding, bedding, scraping in the barn, maternity pens & dry cow facility
- ***You will attend and show at our District 8 Holstein Show in June***
- ***You will attend and assist with our State Show***

A typical day's schedule at the farm includes:

4:30am – 11am ~ Morning Chores

11am – 1:30pm ~ Break (usually a 2 hour break)

2pm – 6:30pm ~ Afternoon tasks (until 4) 4-6:30 Evening Chores

**Sundays are low key, only chores in the morning & at night. Do not have to return until 3:45pm after morning chores are complete.

The ideal candidate for this internship will possess the following traits:

- Willing to work in a team environment and eager to step up when needed
- Takes direction well and open to new ideas
- Is detail oriented and enjoys working in a show environment
- Can be flexible each day as to projects that need to be accomplished
